Sailing your pleasure craft to or from the UK

Make sure you are compliant

Are you arriving from within the EU or leaving the UK?



If you are arriving by pleasure craft from another EU country or leaving the UK and have goods to declare you need to:

- Complete form C1331 – to obtain this visit [gov.uk](https://www.gov.uk) and search ‘**C1331**’

Or if anyone onboard requires immigration clearance you need to:

- Contact the **National Yachtline** on **0300 123 2012**

Are you arriving from outside the EU?



If you are arriving by pleasure craft from a non-EU country (this includes the Channel Islands) you need to:

- Complete form C1331 - to obtain this visit [gov.uk](https://www.gov.uk) and search ‘**C1331**’
- Contact the **National Yachtline** on **0300 123 2012**
- **You must also fly the “Q” flag**

Don't get caught out – complete form C1331 in advance. There are heavy penalties for making false declarations.
