



## PLEASURE CRAFT USERS ARRIVING IN THE UNITED KINGDOMS – CUSTOMS REQUIREMENTS

**(1) If you have arrived directly from another EU Member State**, you do not need to contact Customs unless you have goods to declare or you have been advised that we need to see you. Goods that need to be declared are:

- (i) Animals and birds.
- (ii) Prohibited and restricted goods.
- (iii) Duty free stores.
- (iv) Your vessel, if it is liable to VAT.

If your vessel is liable to VAT, this should be reported to **HMRC** on **03000 516864**. Any other declaration should be made to customs on **0845 723 1110 (National YachtLine)**

**(2) If you have arrived from outside the EU (including the Channel Islands)**, you must contact Customs on the **National YachtLine** on **0845 723 1110** who will ask for information about your vessel, the people on board and any goods you are carrying. You will need to inform the Yacht line if any of the following apply:

- Vat has not been paid on the vessel
- You have any goods in excess of the travellers allowance detailed in Notice 1 travelling to the UK.
- Duty free stores
- You have any prohibited or restricted goods
- There is any notifiable illness on board
- There are any people on board who need immigration clearance (Non EU Nationals)
- Any repairs or modifications, other than running repairs, have been carried out since the vessel last left the EU.

You will need to comply with any further instructions that you are given.

You must also complete **part 2** of form **C1331** and send it to the following address:
